The two larger walls would be about \$3000 to 4000 per wall and the two smaller walls would be about \$2000. The possibility of doing the interior wall method was discussed. Since we really don't use the upstairs during the winter months, it was decided too costly.

A Fall Street Fest or Strassenfest is being planned for Saturday, October 7, 2017 in Plain. The theme for the OFTHS will be "Our Bavarian Ancestors." A motion by Marian and seconded by Bill, to approve the theme. Motion carried.

A schedule for the summer open house was setup as the first and third Sundays June through September from 1:00 to 4:00 pm. The Harrisburg School also has the same schedule and it was agreed to do the same.

The Brat Fund Raiser for June 23 & 24th was discussed. Gene said he would handle the ordering, but Mary Jayne volunteered since she lived in the area. Mary Jayne thought we would have plenty of time to discuss amounts to order at our June 1st meeting.
